

Asphalt Pavement Association of Oregon Education Foundation Scholarship Application

Eligibility:

Applicants must demonstrate an interest in asphalt paving technology or a closely related field and be currently enrolled in an accredited engineering, construction engineering management, or construction trade program at a College, University, or Professional Trade School located in Oregon. Applicants pursuing advanced degrees at Colleges or Universities located in Oregon focused on or related paving technologies are also eligible.

Criteria:

1. Applications must be typed or printed and delivered in one complete package before the Application Deadline,
2. Application must demonstrate an interest in asphalt paving technology and/or a career in a field related to asphalt paving technology.
3. Students must have taken or must demonstrate an intent to take a university or college level course involving asphalt technology. Applicants should direct questions concerning course availability or applicability to the Dean of their College or University or the Asphalt Pavement Association of Oregon Education Foundation.
4. Student must be in good academic standing.
5. Although not required, extracurricular activities, work experience, and a need for financial assistance will be considered and applicants are encouraged to include information relating to these factors in their application.
6. Letters of recommendation are not required but are encouraged. No more than two letters of recommendation will be considered.

Scholarship Award:

Scholarships will be awarded at the Asphalt Pavement Association of Oregon's annual meeting in Portland, Oregon. Scholarship recipients and their guests will be invited to attend the meeting as guests of the Asphalt Pavement Association or Oregon Education Foundation.

Application Deadline:

All applications must be received on or before November 5th of each year.
